These Are the Best Art Galleries in Dubai



Opera Art Gallery DIFC


Jameel Arts Center

Firetti Contemporary

Alserkal Avenue

Known for its thought-provoking exhibits, the most recent one being 'Praxis of Change', Firetti Contemporary is a multidisciplinary art space bringing together regional and international artists. Here you can find a curation of artwork that encourages the importance of individuality while establishing collective alignment. If you're visiting, then we highly recommend the current exhibit, which views art through ecological glasses: How the environment is represented within images and sculptures as well as how the role of humans on Earth is depicted. One of our favorite pieces is by Lebanese artist Charbel Samuel Aoun. Titled 'Earth to Ashes', the artist uses bamboo, pine needles, stones, glass, and wood to portray the relationship between humans and the Earth.
